Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject
noted above I am directed to convey the permission of Director
of Education, Delhi to your Society to start a new school
under district East in Laxmi Nagar area from class Ist to VIII
subject to the following terms and conditions:—

1. That the provision of B.S.E.A., 1973 and rules framed thereunder shall be observed by the Society.
2. That the management of the school will fulfil all the conditions laid down under rules 50 and provide all the facilities given in rules 51 of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 to the institutions.
3. That the management of the school will get the scheme management approved from the Department immediately.
4. That only qualified and trained teachers will be appointed and prescribed scales alongwith all allowances will be paid to the teaching and non-teaching staff through crossed cheques.
5. That the management of school will not ask for grant-in-aid from the department.
6. That the school will not run for the profit of any individual association or a group.
7. That in case at any time the management of school is unable to run the school, the school and all the properties of the school will be transferred to the name of the Director of Education, Delhi.
8. That the management of the school will apply for grant Recognition of the school under the B.S.E.A., 1973 separate and recognition will not be granted unless such statutory provision of section 4(1)(a-f) readwith rules 50 and 51 are fulfilled.
9. That all the recognised classes shall be run at one place.

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That the management of the school will obtained land from DDA in the name of the society for the proposed school through Directorate of Education.

That the proposed school will be run under the banner of Lakshmi Educational Society (Regd) and suitable funds will be made available for the construction of suitable building on the land allotted to the society as declared. The normal size of class room shall be 24x20 sq. ft. and adequate/sufficient class rooms. The proposed school shall be provided for a period of three year from the date of issue of this order. Other than education shall be run.

If recognition of the proposed school is not sought after fulfilling all the above condition within a period of three years. His permission to open a new school shall be treated as cancelled.

Subject: Grant of recognition to the school under Article 17(1) of the Constitution of India (from class I-VIII) without aid from the academic session 1984-85.

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, recognition to your school is granted from class I-VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1984-85 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.

That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the teaching sections should not exceed the number of class-rooms of proper size in the school.

That the school shall not run any pre-primary or non-recognised classes or any other activities within the school premises or in the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery class or removed from the premises of the school, if any, and no branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.

10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the Scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.
12. That the contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 and 51 of the D.S.R.C., 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provisions of Rules 6, 7 and 9 be strictly observed.

That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health certificates may be obtained from the local body within a month.

That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only in a joint account in the name of the Director of Edn. and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.

For the violation of any instructions/orders/circulars/ rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal or recognition of the school. That clause IX of the contract shall not be added to the school without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.

The management of the school shall maintain a list of the staff and the head of the school shall be responsible for the recruitment of staff and the recruitment of staff shall be done in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department.

Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.
9. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately.
10. That immediate action be taken to provide additional furniture, Science equipments, Library books as per norms.
11. That the school shall not apply for further upgradation unless the land is acquired & proper school building is constructed.
12. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
13. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
14. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
15. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificates may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
16. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only).

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17. That the violation of any instructions/orders/ conditions/rules and regulations of the Deptt. shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
18. That the report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to Education Officer every six month.


